

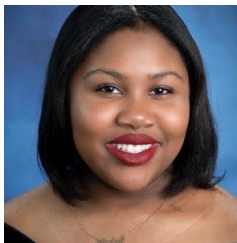

University of Maryland, College Park | Bioengineering

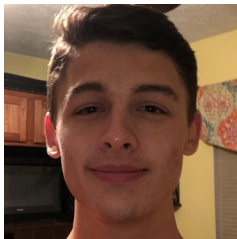
Oluyinka is excited to follow her passion for bioengineering at University of Maryland. *Oluyinka's father, James Akinola, is an employee at Heritage.*

Hood College | Computer Science

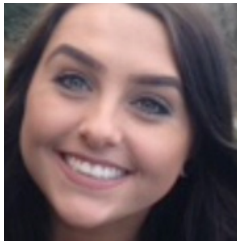

Anne Arundel Community College | Pre-Med

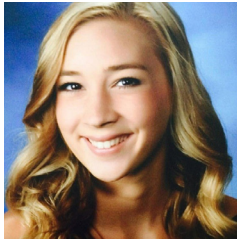

Towson University | Vocal Jazz Performance

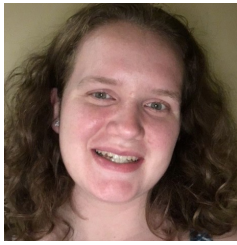

While working full time at Audi Silver Spring, Jesse is taking classes to receive his degree in cybersecurity. *Jessie is an employee at Herb Gordon.*



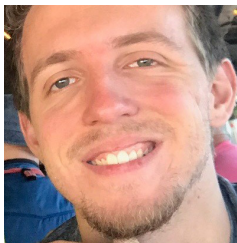
Katelyn Diss

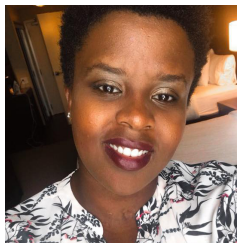
Alyssa Johnson

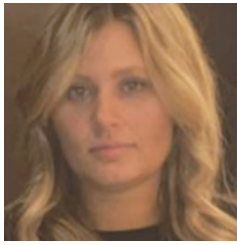
Taylor Liddiard

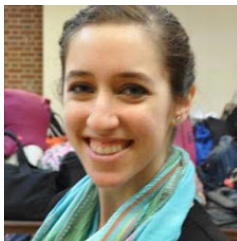
Kelvin Negrón

Harford Community College | Secondary Education

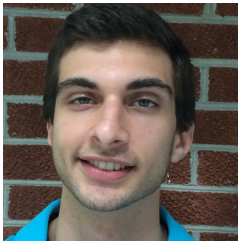

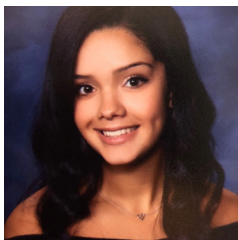
Krista Van Dyke
